

DECLARATION OF “MANITONQUAT” FRANCIS STORY TALBOT

I, Francis Story Talbot, declare:


1. I have personal knowledge of the following facts. If called to testify, I could and would competently testify thereto because these facts are personally known to me to be true.
2. I make this declaration in support of the release of Mitchell J. Stein, who provided pro bono services to my family and many others.
3. I am Manitonquat; it translates to Medicine Story, which I am most known by. My birth name is Francis Story Talbot. I am of the Wampanoag, my ancestors being the first Native Americans to greet the Pilgrimage. I am the Indian that came with the land when our non- profit organization, Another Place Farm, Inc. and Mettanokit Outreach sold the property to The Nature School Foundation in 1999.
4. This declaration is foreign to me, and gave me pause to give it my attention. I am now 84 years of age and as an Elder my time is precious to me, and I do not give any thoughts to the ravaging world of the few who choose to control the many. I have endured many years as a living witness to a magnitude of injustices unable to fend off such powerful and potent attacks, the atrocities my eyes have seen, my ears have heard, and my heart and mind ached in sorrow for those that were suffering such injustice.
5. My declaration here comes from my personal witness of the immense struggle my daughter went through to save The Nature School property where I live upon, to protect me and my wife, and Mission of the foundation to teach Earth Education to children despaired of their connection to the natural world around them, which we all are teachers and students here at the foundation. Earth Education is the understanding that life and education are not separate.
6. In 2006 I was forced into a situation where my home and land that I have a life tenancy was in jeopardy, being forced to be sold by The Nature School Foundation’s Founder. My daughter, Donna, at that time had over one hundred thousand dollars into the repair of the main house. We wanted to move forward with the foundations mission so she invested her own funds.
7. In late 2011 my daughter reached out to Mitchell Stein, a special consultant for Spire Law Group a firm out of CA that was standing up for homeowners nationwide. It was at this moment I really felt her struggles, what she was going through and the intensity of the affects, the toll it had taken, yet she cried too with joy that she knew inside Mitchell Stein was for real. I write this declaration for her, for that very moment that Mitchell

Stein came into our lives and stood beside us to assist us to victory. It was with Mitchell Stein's commitment to us, and mind you there was no money he requested, Donna had found another of the same, a troubleshooter, helper to and for the good of us all.

8. My daughter states emphatically that without Mitchell Stein's invaluable information, and brave stand against the oppressors of justice, she does not know where we would be right now. My daughter calls him our Savoir, an honorable, courageous, loyal brother who is truly committed to the fight for justice for homeowners nationwide.
9. What I am truly sorry for is that this declaration is even necessary. This declaration should be the medal of honor that I am presenting to Mitchell Stein for his tireless and amazing work he has contributed not only to our mission, but on behalf of homeowners across the country, the thousands of plaintiff's that he holds in his heart and mind, who are waiting patiently for him to support them, fight for them, the masses that are in limbo, their justice thwarted by his incarceration.

I believe Mitchell Stein's reputation as a high profile attorney having worked in the financial industry, establishing himself as a formidable opponent, lay way the targeting of him with such a retaliated flavor. I believe that the initial light shown on him was when he filed his first case in mid 2009 against Bank of America, as I believe the investigation was started in the same timeline.
11. I do support Mitchell Stein, I believe he is innocent of the charges he faced, and I believe he was made a target due to his actions on behalf of homeowner.
12. I believe you have convicted and currently are detaining an innocent man, namely being Mitchell J. Stein. Please take this as my declaration to support the release of Mitchell J. Stein.
